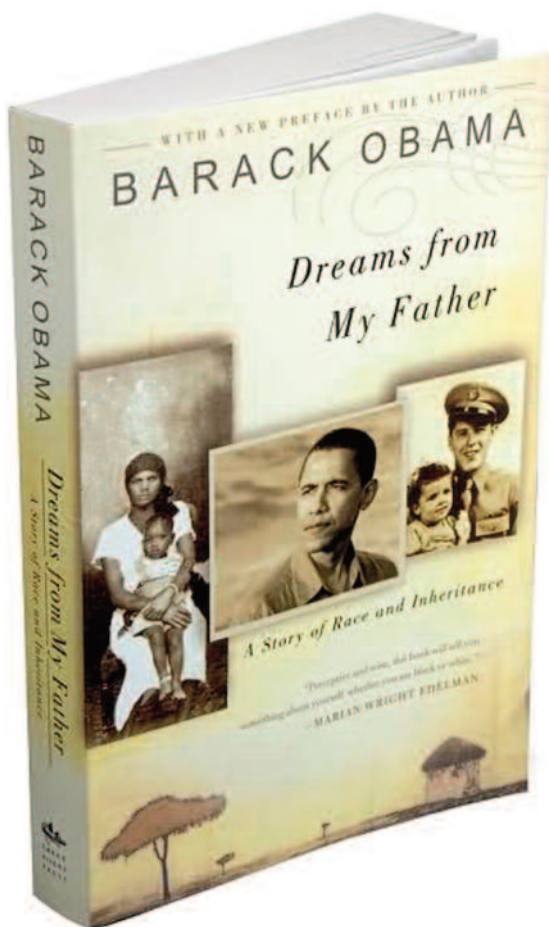

In this lyrical, unsentimental, and compelling memoir, Barack Obama tells the story of his heritage as the son of black African father and a white American mother as he searches for meaning to his life as a black American. It begins in New York, where he learns that his father has been killed in a car accident. This sudden death inspires an emotional odyssey – first to a small town in Kansas, from which he traces the migration of his mother’s family to Hawaii, and then to Kenya, where he meets the African side of his family, confronts the bitter truth of his father’s life, and at last reconciles his divided inheritance.
