## *Remembering John O'Donohue*

**John O'Donohue**, poet, mystic, author of *Anam Cara*, *Eternal Echoes*, *Beauty*, and *To Bless the Space Between Us*, and inspired teacher of thousands in Ireland and around the world, passed away on January 3, 2008.

The retreat on January 3 marks the first anniversary of John's death. It will be a time to honor his memory and draw strength from his teachings. The retreat will be hosted by the Rev. Dr. David Killian, Rector of All Saints Parish, who sponsored John's talks in the Boston area and who was with John for a 10-day retreat in the west of Ireland in May of 2007. He will be joined by John's friends who will share personal remembrances of John, read from John's works, and listen to recordings of John's poems.

Harpist Regina Delaney will sing and play beautiful Celtic music. All are invited to bring their favorite story or reading from John's works to share at the retreat. No fee, but donations are accepted and appreciated. All are invited to the Celtic Holy Eucharist that will follow at 5:00 pm and the pot luck social hour at 6:00 pm.
