Dr. Paul Farmer will receive All Saints Parish Spirituality and Justice Award on Sunday, April 27, during the 10:30 am Holy Eucharist. Dr. Farmer will be the preacher at this service. In 1987, Farmer and colleagues began *Partners in Health* in Cange in the Central Plateau of Haiti. The PIH hospital in Haiti provides free treatment to patients. PIH has developed into a worldwide health organization. In addition to his hospital in Haiti, Farmer oversees projects in Russia, Rwanda, and Peru. PIH helps patients living in poverty to obtain effective drugs to treat tuberculosis and AIDS. He's known for his support of a preferential option for the poor and his commitment to providing quality medical care for people who are poor.
