This Lent we will be exploring the Gospels via scripture and art. Each hour and a half class will look at how each Gospel presents a part of Jesus' life from a particular theological perspective. We will see how they expressed their ideas about Jesus through story and dialog. We will also look at how those perspectives and ideas played out in Christian art over the last 1,500 years.

An exciting, thought-filled course giving much to reflect on, and to add new viewpoints on how to think about Jesus. Taught by the Rev. Chris Visminas whose call is to present solid material for thoughtful, curious Christian adults.

February 10: Beginnings: Truth vs Fact

Why are there 4 different beginnings to each of the 4 gospels? What do they mean? And are they true?

February 17: Commissioning: Baptism, Temptation & Call

What's the role of Jesus' baptism & temptation? How does that relate to the call of the apostles?

February 24: Teaching: Matthew's discourses, Luke's parables and John's discussions

What's the role of Matthew's discourses? What do parables mean? What is Jesus discussing in John?

March 2: Miracles & Signs: Who do you say that I am?

How do the gospels see miracles? Are they just supernatural happenings? Or something else?

March 9: Passion & Death: Politics, Justice and the Meaning of it all

What were the circumstances behind his death? What did Jesus accomplish by dying?

March 16: Resurrection: What's going on here?

Why do the resurrection stories differ from each other? Why is the bodily resurrection important?
